



ELECTROCARDIOGRAM (ECG)

WHAT IT IS

- ♥ An ECG is a procedure used to measure and record the electrical activity of the heart muscle.

PREPARATION AND DURATION

- ♥ There is no preparation for an ECG.
An ECG takes approximately 15 minutes.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ♥ A technologist will bring you into the testing room, explain the test and ask you to remove your shirt and lie down on the exam bed.

ECG electrodes and a monitor will be attached to your chest to acquire the ECG.

RESULTS

- ♥ The results of the ECG will be reviewed and reported by a Cardiologist. The final report will be sent to your family physician.
